Take the A21 and follow the signs for High Elms turning onto Shire Lane. To access the public car park, turn onto High Elms road. For Sat Nav – BR6 7JH.

By Train:

The two nearest stations are Orpington and Chelsfield. Trains run frequently from mainline London train stations to Orpington, from there its a 30 minute walk or 15 minute cycle ride to BEECHE. From the station follow Tubbendenlane down to Farnborough Village High Street, walk through St Giles church yard to Shire Lane, and onto High Elms Country Park.



By Bus:

Bus no. 358 runs every 10 to 15 minutes and stops at Farnborough Village High Street. Bus no. R8 stops outside the centre at bus stop 'High Elms Nature Centre'.

Junior Ranger Academy


This is for our younger rangers, 5-7 year olds.




